Interviews – for invited candidates

Mid to Late April 2020: Tentative job offers begin

Candidates are asked to join us for an 'observation day' to assess if the position is a good fit before accepting the offer.

May through July, 2020: Health screenings & background check

All new Kaiser Permanente employees are subject to a background check, and must complete a health screening, including a TB test and drug screening, before starting work.

Mid to Late July 2020: New employees begin work
